Outdoor enthusiasts can explore Radnor Lake State Park, Deerwood Arboretum & Nature Center and the Dyer Observatory, all located near Brentwood. The Cumberland River, local greenways and nearby parks provide opportunities for hiking, kayaking, biking and wildlife viewing throughout the year.

Nashville is home to the Tennessee Titans (NFL), Nashville Predators (NHL) and Nashville SC (MLS). College sports are also a major draw, with Vanderbilt University and Belmont University offering NCAA Division I athletics just minutes from downtown.
