Downtown San Francisco has a dense, urban feel while surrounding suburbs enjoy ocean views, mountains and thick forests. The cost of living in San Francisco is over 60% higher than the rest of the United States.

San Francisco is a culinary capital where acclaimed chefs and neighborhood kitchens thrive side by side. At Benu in SoMa, inventive Asian-inspired tasting menus showcase creativity and precision. State Bird Provisions in Western Addition delivers playful small plates with bold flavors in a lively setting. For a classic experience, Swan Oyster Depot serves fresh seafood and chowder in an old-school counter atmosphere.





Experience San Francisco's vibrant culture through guided tours of iconic neighborhoods like Chinatown, the Mission District and North Beach. Explore the city's rich diversity at local events such as the Chinese New Year Parade, Carnaval San Francisco and the Nihonmachi Street Fair in Japantown. Outdoor Activities, Sports & Entertainment



San Francisco offers dramatic natural beauty in and beyond its city streets. Golden Gate Park stretches over 1,000 acres with gardens, trails and open space for every activity. The Presidio provides wooded hills, coastal bluffs and iconic views of the Golden Gate Bridge. Crissy Field's shoreline is popular for running, kite flying and family outings against a backdrop of the bay.

San Francisco is a major sports hub with a passionate fan base and a deep-rooted athletic tradition. The city is home to the San Francisco 49ers (NFL), who play at Levi's Stadium in nearby Santa Clara, and the San Francisco Giants (MLB), who play at the scenic Oracle Park. Just across the Bay, the Golden State Warriors (NBA) light up Chase Center in San Francisco's Mission Bay neighborhood. Soccer fans can also catch Bay FC, the city's new National Women's Soccer League (NWSL) team.





San Francisco's cultural life blends historic institutions with cutting-edge creativity. The War Memorial Opera House hosts the San Francisco Opera and Ballet in a landmark setting. The Fillmore continues its legacy as one of the city's premier live music stages. Broadway tours and local productions light up theaters such as the Orpheum, while neighborhood venues offer intimate performances. Museums like SFMOMA and the de Young showcase world-class collections that span modern and global art.

San Francisco has a diverse and innovation-driven economy anchored by leading industries such as technology, finance, healthcare and tourism. San Francisco is surrounded by destinations that make for easy escapes. To the north, Marin County features redwood forests at Muir Woods and coastal trails at Point Reyes. Farther east, Lake Tahoe provides mountain scenery, outdoor recreation and a true four-season getaway.
