Green Lake draws walkers, joggers and paddleboarders, while the Burke-Gilman Trail provides miles of scenic paths for cyclists and runners. With Mount Rainier visible on clear days and countless nearby trails, Seattle offers an ideal balance of city life and nature.

Seattle has a strong sports culture built around loyal fans and a deep sense of community pride. The city is home to the Seahawks (NFL), Mariners (MLB), Kraken (NHL) and Sounders FC (MLS), each drawing passionate crowds throughout the year. Leading companies include Amazon, Microsoft, Boeing and Alaska Airlines, along with institutions like the University of Washington and Providence Health.
